With most items priced at \$2 or less, FOL's spring and fall book sales generate approximately \$20,000 annually for specialized databases, network access, books, e-books, periodicals, and other materials to keep the Fernandina Beach Library current. 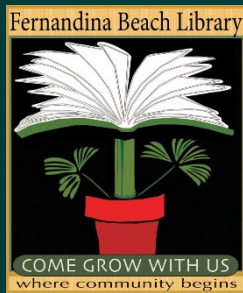
